Praise the 2018 Youth Advocates for their time and commitment in completing their fundraising goals. Pray for our Youth Advocates as they continue to support leprosy affected people, families and communities.

Our 2019 Youth Advocates are raising funds for the upgrade of a vehicle for the effective delivery of services at the Leprosy Mission's Anandaban Hospital. Pray for successful fundraising initiatives for Youth Advocates and that more people will be willing to support those affected by leprosy.

New Opportunities

Monday 8 July

Give thanks for the re-engagement of Rhema FM. As Rhema FM partner with LMNZ to highlight on air the Cure One programme, pray that many of the listeners respond to the call to action. Pray that the wider New Zealand community will open their hearts in love and

compassion, and that they would be encouraged by the many messages on air to support people affected by leprosy.

Tuesday 9 July

Pray that the many listeners to Rhema FM belonging to different churches will choose to recognise people affected by leprosy in forthcoming events or services and that their congregations will be inspired to greater support and involvement.

Wednesday 10 July

Praise the Lord! Muzaffarpur Hospital which New Zealand has supported for many years in India is now self-sustaining and able to provide leprosy treatment free to people affected by leprosy. This is paid for through fee paying from general patients. This allows LMNZ to now raise funds for Salun Hospital as a new opportunity in India. Pray for the success of this initiative.

Thursday 11 July

The Leprosy Mission New Zealand now supports The Leprosy Mission Trust India's Children United for Action educational initiative. Pray that through this programme, children affected by leprosy from vulnerable backgrounds will receive educational opportunities and grow in self-esteem and self-confidence.

Friday 12 July

The Leprosy Mission Timor Leste has been active since 2003, pushing towards elimination of leprosy and the decrease of discrimination against persons with leprosy and disability, so that they can be fully integrated in their communities. We pray for unity and agreement within the leadership structures as they move towards establishing a local Board.

Saturday 13 July/ Sunday 14 July

We pray for TLM Italy, a small group that work on a voluntary basis, and their desire to join the Global Fellowship. Their greatest need is to find more supporters and involve them in the work. Pray for the Italian public to be inspired to support the work of The Leprosy Mission Italy.

Annual Appeal

Monday 15 July

We are writing to our supporters about Heizen a twelve year old boy who has not returned to school because he has been ostracised by his school friends for having leprosy. Pray the Annual Appeal is well received and people open their hearts to support our work in Papua New Guinea. Pray that the Annual Appeal reaches its target and that we are able to help Heizen and others like him who are affected by leprosy.

Tuesday 16 July

The Leprosy Mission is leading the work in Papua New Guinea. Through the 'Sustainable Livelihoods Development Project', the New Zealand Aid Programme is also matching our fundraising with \$4 for every \$1 that is donated to the match target. Pray New Zealand supporters will take advantage of this opportunity to multiply their impact and support this Annual Appeal.

Wednesday 17 July

Heizen lives in a poverty-stricken area of Port Moresby, the capital of Papua New Guinea. He enjoyed learning and especially playing touch rugby with his friends. Leprosy has caused his hands to claw and he finds it difficult to catch the rugby ball. Pray for the cure, care and restoration of children like Heizen and that they will have a future free from leprosy.

Thursday 18 July

The heartbreaking reality is that without access to the full 12 month cure for leprosy, Heizen's hand will continue to claw and he will never be able to perform even simple tasks or play his beloved rugby. Pray for the Leprosy Mission volunteer Community Facilitators who refer children like Hezien for diagnosis and support them at the health centres to ensure they receive the full course of the cure.

Friday 19 July

Give thanks to our loyal supporters who bless our work with their gifts that allow children like Heizen and others to be able to receive a cure – and hope for a future that is free from the curse of leprosy. Give thanks for the compassion and love they show

when they help to transform the lives of leprosy-affected people all over the world.

Saturday 20 July / Sunday 21 July

Praise God for the New Zealand Government's Aid Programmes on-going support for our projects in Papua New Guinea and Bougainville. Praise also for the thousands of NZ supporters for donating to and praying for this work. Pray for all staff in Papua New Guinea and Bougainville as they look at creating income generation opportunities which will help lift communities out of poverty and give them a future free from leprosy.
