

Saturday 2 November/Sunday 3 November

Please pray that the installation of tanks at eight villages can be carried out as planned. This is part of the Climate Change Resilience Project, which aims to increase community resilience to climate vulnerability and change.

Myanmar**Monday 4 November**

Pray for people affected by leprosy in Myanmar. May they be protected from the ongoing conflicts and natural disasters. Some are facing difficulty travelling due to political conflict, war, and natural disasters, thus making it difficult for them to seek medical treatment at hospitals and obtain MDT. Please pray for safe travel to medical facilities and that TLM Myanmar can provide them with the necessary medication for their treatment.

Tuesday 5 November

Pray for the healthcare workers, church leaders, and volunteers who are working tirelessly to help those people affected by leprosy. Pray for the strength, wisdom, and resources they need to continue their compassionate service.

Wednesday 6 November

Please pray for those affected by floods, especially people affected by leprosy and disability. Pray for safety, comfort and protection during this time. Villages where projects are being implemented are also facing the effects of the floods. Please pray that people will be able to get the basic needs of food, shelter, and resources for them to recover. Although it is the rainy season there is still intense heat in dry zones so prayer is needed to reduce health problems caused by extreme weather.

Thursday 7 November

In Pakokku region, the electricity supply is being interrupted every five hours and work delays are caused when the generator breaks down. Pray for the generator to be repaired quickly and the electricity supply to be stabilized, so that the work may continue without interruption.

Friday 8 November

Phase 2 of construction of a new building in Sittwe is underway. Please pray for the completion of this project within the expected timeframe, ensuring the safety of all involved at the construction site. Pray for peace of mind to all the employees working on this project so they can feel safe and secure in their work.

Saturday 9 November/Sunday 10 November

Pray for the operations of the mobile workshop team in northern Shan State to run smoothly. Bless the procurement process for additional materials. Pray for the delivery of materials to be timely and without any obstacles so that the team of TLM Myanmar can continue serving those in need.

Nepal**Monday 11 November**

Please pray for all people affected by leprosy receiving treatment from Anandaban Hospital. Pray for complete healing and for the prevention of possible complications during treatment. Pray that the wounds heal without complications, and for completely successful surgical outcomes for all those undergoing reconstructive surgery.

Tuesday 12 November

Give glory to God for the new self-care unit which has begun operating in the new building. Please pray for the team to be able to train patients so that their ability to care for their wounds and disabilities increases. This should lead to a decrease in re-admissions as patients become more confident and capable.

Wednesday 13 November

Please pray that all patients who have been stigmatized and have some form of mental health problem can receive proper treatment and counselling. Pray that this will lead to recovery and well-being. Please pray that people affected by leprosy can be rehabilitated to their own communities and live without fear of stigma

Thursday 14 November

Give thanks for the satellite clinics of Anandaban Hospital, which are in Butwal, Biratnagar and Chitwal. People affected by leprosy can be diagnosed and receive treatment for the condition at the clinics. Pray that many people affected by leprosy will feel safe to attend the clinics and will be cured and restored to dignity.

Friday 15 November

Please pray that Skin Camps can continue to be run and that hidden cases of leprosy can be diagnosed through the Skin Camps. Give thanks for people who have been diagnosed with leprosy and pray for complete healing and restoration.

Saturday 16 November/ Sunday 17 November

Give thanks for all the people working to defeat leprosy and see lives transformed in Nepal. Pray that they will develop empathy, sensitivity and wisdom in their relationships with the people they serve. Please pray that through these relationships and the treatment they receive people affected by leprosy will find hope and healing.

Bougainville**Monday 18 November**

The contract has been signed for the next five-year phase of the Bougainville Healthy Communities Programme. Full support and collaboration is needed between all parties involved. A Memorandum of Understanding has been prepared, specifying the roles of each party in the BHCP. Please pray that all the parties will have the wisdom and understanding to sign the MOU. Pray for stronger working relationships between the parties for the benefit of people affected by leprosy and other health issues in the communities.

Tuesday 19 November

Programme staff of the BHCP will undergo training on TB and HIV as part of the Health Promotion Curriculum design facilitated by the Health Department of the Autonomous Bougainville Government. Please pray that the training will be practical and helpful and that everyone involved will learn a lot to help people in the communities.

There is increased violence in many communities because of social issues and sorcery. This has caused insecurity, and the safety of staff and volunteers is at risk. Please pray for the safety of community members, staff and volunteers as they live and work in these communities.

Friday 22 November

As more work on tracking leprosy is carried out by the Leprosy Control Officer of the Dept. of Health more patients are being diagnosed and starting treatment on Multi-Drug Therapy. Give thanks that the antibiotics are readily available and pray that the good supply will continue.

Saturday 23 November/ Sunday 24 November

The working relationship between the staff of health facilities, the Leprosy Control Officer and treatment supporters is strong and cases of leprosy are being registered at the health facilities. Please continue to thank and praise God for saving the lives of people affected by leprosy who are being cured.

Kiribati

Monday 25 November

Please pray for peace and harmony as a new government settles into power in Kiribati. Give thanks for the elected MPs and pray that the future strategies of the new government will be favourable for the implementation of the PHACE Programme. Please pray for a strong partnership between the Government of Kiribati, the NZ Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade and The Leprosy Mission NZ.

Tuesday 26 November

Pray for God's grace upon the Dept of Finance in Kiribati, as the funding for the PHACE Programme is managed through this department. Please pray for the highest levels of integrity and accountability to be maintained for the funds to be used for the neediest people in the community.

Wednesday 27 November

Commit to the Lord all the activities planned for this year. Pray that the PHACE Programme can be implemented well in the chosen communities. Pray that there won't be political, social, economic, climatic or logistical hindrances, so the PHACE Programme can begin to be established and have a positive effect for people affected by leprosy and other conditions.

Thursday 28 November

Please pray that all associated non-governmental organisations and other stakeholders in PHACE will be motivated for the benefit of the people in the communities. Please pray that positive network relationships will develop to allow great impact on people's lives.

Friday 29 November

Saturday 30 November/ Sunday 1 December

Please pray for the four programme volunteers who are working tirelessly in the communities. They raise awareness of the importance of knowledge and action around personal and family health.
